



MORE IN TLV

DIZENGOFF

We recommend a walk on Dizengoff Street, which is full of bars and restaurants of all kinds.

A magical pen shop - 74 Dizengoff Street (tell Shimon that you came from Guy and Barbara:))

The mythical Dizengoff Square, where you can sit and enjoy the unique atmosphere.

Dizengoff Center - a large, air-conditioned shopping center (it is recommended to look for the fairy shop in building B, level 6)



ROTHSCHILD BOULEVARD AND HABIMA SQUARE

The first boulevard of Tel Aviv!

Restaurants, bars and a Tel Aviv atmosphere can be found on the boulevard that ends at the mythical Habima Square, which is also surrounded by many cafes.

In the area of Habima Square - it is recommended to visit the "Rubina" bar at the HaBima Square, or coffee and pastries at "Lachmanina" (4 Marmorek st.).





NEARBY BREAKFAST

Here some specific breakfast / brunch places near the hotel, the flea market area and Jaffa port.

Highly recommended

 **It is recommended to arrive on foot / scooter.**

 **If you prefer by car**

On a weekend it is recommended to park behind Bloomfield stadium and not enter the market area with the vehicle.

At the second traffic light turn right onto Shalavim Street, at the first traffic light turn left onto HaTehiyah Street and look for parking. From there within 5 minutes you are at the flea market that starts from Olei Zion Street.

In the middle of the week there is less traffic and you can park in the West Coast parking lot, or the Etzel House parking lot.

1) Delicatessen - Panorama Building, 84 Derekh Yafo, Tel Aviv-Yafo.

2) Raisa - 8 Rabbi Yochanan st. Tel Aviv-Yafo

3) Puah - close to Raisa :) (Closed on Saturday)

4) Farouk - on the street parallel to the previous ones. 6 Rabbi Nachman st. Tel Aviv-Yafo.

5) Jaffa Port - Vista Cafe -

48 Second Aliyah Pier st, Tel Aviv-Yafo

6) Humus Nader - at the intersection of Shalavim Street and Ben Zvi Road. 35 Ben Zvi Road st. Tel Aviv-Yafo. (Less than 10 minutes walk from the hotel)

NATURE GARDENS - THE BOTANICAL GARDEN

In front of the hotel across the road is a charming park.

Huge garden, with playgrounds, fitness facilities and a picnic area.

In the heart of the park is the Russian Church, which can be visited but the waiting outside must be taken into account.

Further down the path after the church is a charming botanical garden suitable for a romantic walk or for the whole family.

The garden area is 16 dunams and contains hundreds of wild plants typical of the country.

In the garden there are ponds and swamps where hydrophilic vegetation grows, and fish and turtles live.
